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HEALTH and SAFETY CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO A KERIKERI IRRIGATION SITE

The Kerikeri Irrigation Co. is committed to its obligations under the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 to provide, as far as practicable, a safe and healthy working environment for workers and visitors (including contractors).

The company requires that any persons entering any Kerikeri Irrigation site for whatever reason will always conduct themselves in a safe manner and not put themselves, our staff, or others at risk.

Contractors or subcontractors must familiarise themselves with the work area and any potential hazards prior to commencing work.

Visitors acknowledges that:

- 1. As a visitor, you understand your obligations and responsibilities, and that of any employees and sub-contractors, under the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015, and will usebest practices to meet the requirements of the Act and its regulations, codes of practice and safety standards applying to the trade or profession within which you operate.
- 2. You agree that the principals' representative may monitor progress of work and to inspect the worksite at any time to ensure safe practices are being observed.
- 3. No person other than employees, subcontractors and their employees, and the principal's employees are allowed access to the worksite.
- 4. All employees and sub-contractors utilised are fully trained in the work to be undertaken or will be closely supervised by someone who is.
- 5. All safety clothing or equipment required to minimise the risk of injury will be provided for, accessible to and used by any person engaged on the contracted works.
- 6. You will advise the principal of any accidents or incidents, or of any hazards recognised in the workplace.
